

**RICHMOND COUNTY MUNICIPAL COUNCIL**

**SPECIAL MEETING**

**JUNE 16, 2008**

Location: Council Chambers, Municipal Office

Warden Boudreau called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m., and asked everyone to stand for the singing of O'Canada.

The Clerk took roll call of Councillors.

Consideration of a Recommendation to Order Demolition:

(i) Report from Administrator

Mr. Bain addressed Council, and summarized the history of attempts to have the dangerous and unsightly property remedied. Mr. Bain described the dangerous conditions of the property and building, and recommended that Council issue an Order, to include demolition of the dangerous building, filling in the basement, and removing and properly disposing of the debris.

(ii) Opportunity for Owner Representation

Warden Boudreau invited the owner, or representatives of the owner, to come forward and communicate with Council.

Warden Boudreau requested that it be noted in the minutes that no one has come forward to represent the owners.

Warden Boudreau then opened the floor to questions from Councillors.

(iii) Consideration of Order to Demolish

Moved by Councillor Beaton, seconded by Councillor Cotton that Municipal Council accept the recommendation of the Administrator, and the Planning Advisory Committee, and issue the Order for demolition of the property owned by the Estate of Alcide J. Sampson in D'Escousse, District #3, with the demolition order to include demolition of the building, filling in of the basement with suitable materials, and proper removal and disposal of the resulting debris. Motion carried.

Moved by Councillor Boudreau, seconded by Councillor McNamara that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried.
