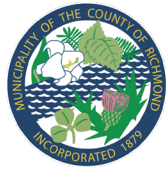
Sgt. Brad Kelly provided a debriefing on the action taken on illegal cannabis stores.

Speed radar unit – Traffic speed concerns in Louisdale
