1. **ITEM:** Atlantic Biosphere Project

2. **BACKGROUND:**
 - (a) **Define/explain issue:** Proposal from Elwin Stieger of Louisdale to participate in Weston Foundations Homegrown Innovation Challenge. ABP has finished the design of a residential greenhouse for off-season application. Proof of concept built started already and in line with Weston Foundation Shephard phase.
