**POLICY NAME: POLICY FOR PROVIDING BOOSTER PUMPS TO RESIDENTS OF RICHMOND COUNTY UNDER THE RICHMOND COUNTY WATER UTILITY WHO ARE EXPERIENCING LOW WATER PRESSURE**

**APPROVAL DATE: JANUARY 13, 2003**

1. Residents in the low water pressure zone immediately around the Arichat Water storage tank will be eligible for the supply, installation and maintenance of a booster pump assembly by the Utility.
2. In addition, a sum of \$150.00 will be provided for the cost of incidental materials required for installation of the booster pump assembly. Utility staff in consultation with the homeowner will carry out reasonable reinstatement of building materials around the booster pump assembly installation area in accordance with the budget amount. Any cost in excess of the budget amount for the installation of the booster pump assembly will be paid by the homeowner.
3. Residences in the low water pressure zone who have installed booster pump assemblies prior to the adoption of this policy will be reimbursed for the cost of supply and installation up to an amount of \$650.00. Residents will be required to supply proof satisfactory to the Utility staff as to the purchase and installation of the booster pump.
4. Upon installation of a booster pump assembly or payment pursuant to paragraph 3 of this policy, the booster pump assembly will become the property of the Utility. Representatives of the Utility will have access to all parts of the customer's premises at all reasonable hours for the purpose of servicing the booster pump assembly.
5. No person will alter, change or remove the assembly without written permission of the Utility.
6. Eligibility for coverage by this policy will be in the sole discretion of the Richmond County Water Utility Staff.
