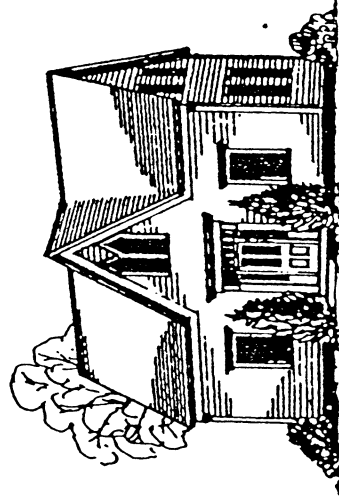
GREEK REVIVAL
1830 - 1930



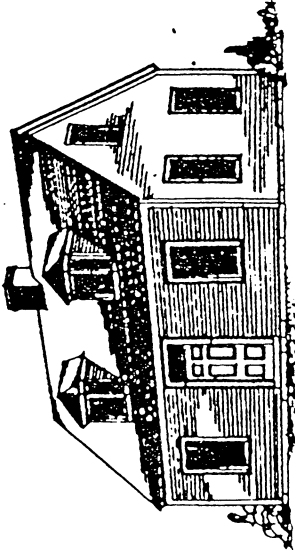
THE FOUR SQUARE
1890 - 1930



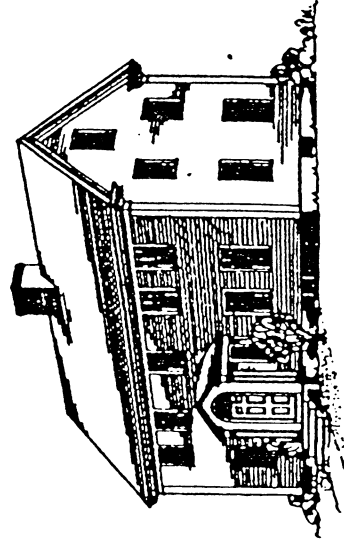
SECOND EMPIRE
