



POSITION: Surf Instructor Assistant (1 position available)
LOCATION: Point Michaud Provincial Park, Richmond County
SALARY: \$17.50/hour - 35 hours per week – 10 weeks

Reporting to the Director of Community Development and Recreation, the **Surf Instructor Assistant** supports the Surf Instructor in delivering surf instruction to participants of all ages at Point Michaud Beach. Working collaboratively with a team, the successful candidate will help create safe, positive, and inclusive experiences. This position is based on a 35-hour work week and includes weekend work.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Surf Instructor Assistant will shadow and assist the Surf Instructor and all times. He/she will report to the staff of Recreation Department and will be asked to:

- Assist Surf Instructor with planning surfing lessons 5 days per week
- Assist the Surfing Coordinator/Surf Instructor with equipment rentals as well as coordinate equipment rentals for the Unama'ki Surf Program
- Assist with maintaining cleanliness of surf equipment
- Assist with the planning/coordination of our annual Surf Classic
- Exercise safety precautions at all times to ensure the safety of participants
- Other responsibilities as designated by the staff of the Recreation Department

REQUIREMENTS:

- First Aid/CPR *
- WHMIS/OHS certificates *
- Vulnerable Sector/Criminal Record Check *
- Child Abuse Registry Check *
- Strong communication skills
- Experience working with children is an asset
