

POSITION: Surf Instructor (1 position available)

LOCATION: Point Michaud Beach

**SALARY: \$17.50-\$25/hour (based on experience)
35 hours per week/10 weeks**

Reporting to the Director of Community Development and Recreation, the **Surf Instructor** provides surf instruction to participants of all ages at Point Michaud Beach. The role requires planning and coordinating lessons for learners of all skill levels while working collaboratively with a team to ensure safe, positive, and inclusive experiences. This position is based on a 35-hour work week and includes weekend work.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Surf Instructors will report to the staff of Recreation Department and will be asked to:

- Plan, organize, and instruct beginner to intermediate surfing lessons for individuals and groups
- Deliver clear and age-appropriate surf safety instruction
- Demonstrate proper surfing techniques and the correct use of equipment
- Adapt lesson plans based on weather, surf conditions, and safety requirements
- Manage lesson scheduling, including changes and cancellations due to ocean or weather conditions
- Instruct and supervise participants in a safe, fun, and supportive environment
- Communicate effectively with parents regarding participant progress, safety, and expectations
- Foster a positive, encouraging, and inclusive learning atmosphere for all participants
- Manage group dynamics to ensure participants feel comfortable, supported, and included
- Respond to parent questions and concerns in a professional and friendly manner
- Provide guidance and mentorship to Surf Assistant
- Perform other related duties as assigned by the Recreation Department

REQUIREMENTS:

- Bronze Medallion
- First Aid/CPR *
- WHMIS/OHS certificates *
- Strong communication skills
- Experience working with children is an asset
- Vulnerable Sector/Criminal Record Check *
- Child Abuse Registry Check *

* If an applicant does not have these certificates/training, the Recreation Department will provide the successful candidate with the training prior to the first lesson.
