

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE REPORT
FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH 2013

The Committee has met once since the last Council Meeting.

The Committee reviewed the Property of Gregory and Mary Rude.

I move that Council accept the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole and that an “Order to Remedy Condition” be issued to Gregory and Mary Rude, 3661 Highway 206, Haut De Le Baie, NS, (PID #75011015; AAN # 01415298), and that the Order be a Demolition Order issued from Council to the owners instructing that the house be demolished and all debris be removed from the property within thirty (30) days or the Municipality will complete the same and recover the costs through property taxes”.

The Committee reviewed the Priority Setting Workshop Summary Report.

I move that Council accept the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole and that the CAO and staff translate and implement Council’s priorities through:
