

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE REPORT
FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER, 2013

The Committee has met once since the last Council Meeting.

The Committee reviewed the West Richmond Education Centre.

I move that Council accept the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole and that an expression of interest be sought regarding the West Richmond Education Centre property.

The Committee reviewed a request from GASHA for reimbursement of physician relocation expenses for Dr. Jonah Samson.

I move that Council accept the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole and that the request by GASHA to reimburse the relocation expenses incurred by Dr. Jonah Samson in the amount of \$11,523.90 be approved.

The Committee reviewed a request for a proclamation from the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Review Officer.

I move that Council accept the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole and that Richmond Municipal Council proclaim the week of September 23 to September 28, 2013 as “Right to Know Week” in Richmond County in order to raise awareness of the right to access information and its value, with a local focus on what it means to those living and working in Nova Scotia.

The Committee reviewed the property of Gary and Kathleen Pretty.

I move that Council accept the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole and that an “Order to Remedy Condition” be issued to Gary and Kathleen Pretty, St. Peters Fourchu Road, Framboise, NS PID #75082990, AAN #00810029, and that the Order be a Demolition Order issued from Council to the owners of said property, instructing that both the dwelling unit and storage garage be demolished and all debris be removed from the property within thirty (30) days or the Municipality will complete the same and recover the costs through property taxes.

The Committee reviewed grant requests.

I move that Council accept the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole and that the following grant requests be approved:

- \$500 to Development Isle Madame Association, Municipal District Activity Fund, District #1;
- \$500 to Sacred Heart Ladies Group, Municipal District Activity Fund, District #10;
- \$300 to Acadiaville Community Centre Society, Municipal District Activity Fund, District #4;
