

**COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE REPORT**

**FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER 2016**

The Committee has met once since the last Council Meeting.

The Committee reviewed a Dangerous & Unsightly property.

I move that Council accept the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole and the Eastern District Planning Commission and that an “Order to Remedy Condition” be issued to Shane and Tina Murphy, 169 Chapel Cove Road, L’Ardoise, Nova Scotia, Property Identifiers (PID) 75072355, Assessment Account (AAN) 03280128 and that the Order be a Demolition Order issued from Council to the owners. The Order should state to the owners that the dwelling is to be demolished and all debris be removed and disposed of in the appropriate manner within thirty (30) days. If the property owner fails to comply the Municipality will complete the same and recover the costs.

The Committee reviewed the Richmond County Expense Claims Publication policy.

I move that Council accept the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole and adopt the Richmond County “Expense Claims Publication “Policy to enable all expenses of Richmond County Council and the Chief Administrative Officer to be posted online. (Attached as Appendix “A”).
