The Committee has met once since the last Council meeting.

The Committee reviewed Board member vacancies.

I move that Council accept the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole and that Lester Joseph Fougere be appointed to serve as a member at large on the St. Peter's, Samsonville and Area Water Utility Board.

I move that Council accept the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole and that Marie Briand be appointed to serve as a member at large on the Richmond Villa Board.

I move that Council accept the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole and that Deputy Warden Martell be the alternate member to serve as the Richmond County representative on the Strait Area Transit Board

The Committee reviewed requests for Road Name Changes

I move that Council accept the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole and that the Road Name Change Petition form submitted by the residents of Grand Anse to name an unnamed private land to Rae Cove Way be approved

I move that Council accept the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole and that the Road Name Change Petition form submitted by a resident of Janvrin Harbour to change an unnamed "k" class road to Carrigan Road be approved.
