The Committee met on March 9, 2020.

The Committee discussed a Clean-up Order

I move that Council accept the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole and that an extension to June 15, 2020 be granted regarding the appeal submitted by the property owner for an extension to the 14 day Clean-up Order, previously issued on January 29, 2020

The Committee discussed the CBREN

I move that Council accept the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole and that the Municipality of the County of Richmond remain as a member of the Cape Breton Regional Enterprise Network for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021.

The Committee discussed Physician/Healthcare Recruitment
