

RICHMOND COUNTY MUNICIPAL COUNCIL

SPECIAL MEETING

MARCH 24, 2004

Location: Court House, Arichat

Warden Johnson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and the Clerk took roll call of Councillors.

Committee Reports:

(i) Planning Advisory Committee

Councillor McNamara presented the monthly report of the Planning Advisory Committee (copy attached).

Moved by Councillor McNamara, seconded by Councillor MacNeil that Council accept the recommendation of the Planning Advisory Committee and give First Reading approval to the request from Mr. Blair Stone, C & M Rentals, to amend the St. Peter's Land Use By-Law, by rezoning the subject property, as outlined in the attached staff report, from Village Residential (R-1) zone to Mixed Use (C-2) zone; and further moved that Council establish a Public Hearing date of 6:30 p.m., April 13, 2004 at the Arichat Court House, to be followed by the Regular Council Meeting at 7:00 p.m., to consider Second Reading approval. Motion carried.

Moved by Councillor McNamara, seconded by Deputy Warden Bourque that the monthly report of the Planning Advisory Committee be accepted as presented. Motion carried.

(ii) Committee of the Whole

Deputy Warden Bourque presented the monthly report of the Committee of the Whole (copy attached).

Moved by Deputy Warden Bourque, seconded by Councillor Cotton that Council accept the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole and appoint Mr. Bobby Sampson as the Returning Officer for the 2004 Municipal Election. Motion carried.

Moved by Deputy Warden Bourque, seconded by Councillor Beaton that Council accept the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole and that a letter be written to the Department of Natural Resources requesting that the Lennox Passage Park be placed on the Department's priority list for improvements, and requesting permission to use the Park as a dry camping facility during the C.M.A. celebrations; and further moved that the Park be evaluated in order to determine if a permanent campsite can be established at this park. Motion carried.

Moved by Deputy Warden Bourque, seconded by Councillor Sampson that Council accept the recommendation of the Vested Property Clerk and the Committee of the Whole and sell the former Fleur de Lis Tavern property to Mr. Scott Mombourquette, at his tender bid of \$2,000. Motion carried.

Moved by Deputy Warden Bourque, seconded by Councillor McNamara that Council accept the recommendation of the Deputy Clerk and the Committee of the Whole and award the tender for municipal insurance for the fiscal year commencing April 1, 2004 to Fraser & Hoyt at their low tender bid of \$78,740. Motion carried.

Moved by Deputy Warden Bourque, seconded by Councillor Sampson that the monthly report of the Committee of the Whole be accepted as presented. Motion carried.
