Warden Marchand called the meeting to order at 7:10 PM

Moved by Councillor Goyetche, seconded by Deputy Warden Martell that Council approve the 5 year Capital Investment Plan for the Municipality of the County of Richmond for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2021. Motion carried.

Moved by Councillor Boucher, seconded by Deputy Warden Martell that Council accept the recommendation of the Chief Financial Officer and that the following area rates be approved:

St. Peter's Fire Department 0.09

West Bay Road Fire Dept. 0.10

L'Ardoise Fire Dept. 0.16

Grand River Fire Dept. 0.15

Loch Lomond Fire Dept. 0.15

St. Peter's Village Commission – collect whatever rate they establish, conditional on them providing their rate to the Municipality by July 31, 2020. Motion carried. (Nay: Councillor MacLean)

Moved by Councillor Goyetche, seconded by Councillor Boucher that Municipal Council give approval to the municipal estimates of revenues and expenditures for the year ending March 31, 2021 in the amount of \$13,769,100;

AND FURTHER MOVED THAT WHEREAS pursuant to the Municipal Act, the Municipal Council of the Municipality of Richmond estimates that sums amounting to \$8,787,051 are required for the lawful purpose of the said Municipality for the year ending March 31, 2021, after crediting the probable revenue from all sources other than rates for the said year and making due allowance for the abatement and losses which may occur in the collection of the taxes and for taxes for the said year which may not be collectible or collected;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that Richmond Council hereby authorizes the levying and collection of a residential rate of .80¢ on each \$100 of the assessed value of residential property assessed on the assessment roll and a commercial rate of \$2.10; which rates said Council deems sufficient to raise the sums required to defray the expenditures of the said Municipality for this year, and any deficit from the preceding years;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Richmond Council hereby imposes an additional percentage charge of 18 percent per annum on all rates and taxes remaining unpaid;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Richmond Council hereby fixes the 30th day of September, 2020 as the day on which the Tax Collector or Treasurer may proceed to issue warrants for the collection of all rates and taxes then unpaid. Motion carried. (Nay: Councillor MacLean)

Moved by Councillor Boucher, seconded by Deputy Warden Martell that the meeting move to an "In Camera" Session at 7:31 p.m.

Moved by Councillor Boucher, seconded by Deputy Warden Martell that the meeting revert back to Regular Session at 7:41 p.m.

Moved by Deputy Warden Martell, seconded by Councillor Goyetche that Richmond Municipal Council hire Don Marchand in the position of Chief Administrative Officer, for a 5 year term, effective June 1, 2020. Motion carried.

Adjournment

Moved by Deputy Warden Martell, seconded by Councillor Boucher that the meeting be adjourned.
